ABOUT THE GRANT

OFCFA received a \$200,000 grant from the US Department of Health & Human Services designated for firefighter health. Focused on firefighter behavioral health, we partnered with the International Association of Firefighters to provide FREE peer support training statewide. Through this partnership, 325 Ohio first responders received this life-saving training.

183 students, including firefighters, EMTs, dispatchers & police officers attended one of 12 in-person two-day classes

76 students participated in the two-day online virtual training option focused on building individual and organizational resilience.
